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RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The American Legion Riders Department of California Bylaws Article XI, Section 1, Third Sentence states, *“Each committee member shall serve a term of three (3) years, or until a successor is appointed.”*; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion Riders Department of California Bylaws Article XI, Section 2 states, *“No person shall serve on the same Department committee for more than one (1) consecutive terms (a term defined as three (3) years) or three (3) consecutive years”*; and

WHEREAS, Each year at the American Legion Riders Department of California State Convention during the Area Caucuses (and afterwards) delegates volunteer to serve on a Department Standing Committee for the upcoming year; and

WHEREAS Committee members are appointed by the Director and the Department executive Committee; and

WHEREAS, Often there are times when it is difficult to find an adequate number of volunteers to make the committees operate smoothly and in a productive fashion, and

WHEREAS, It becomes necessary for committee members to volunteer beyond the current restrictions of tenure in or to keep the committee running and productive; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED, By The American Legion Riders Department of California at the Department Convention in Norco, California, on April 18-19, 2026, that the Department of California American Legion Riders Bylaws Article XI, Section 1, the third sentence be changed to read, *“Each committee member shall serve a term of up to three (3) years, or until a successor is appointed.”*; and be it also**

**RESOLVED, That Article XI, Section 2 be struck from the Bylaws; and be it finally**

**RESOLVED, that the remaining Sections be numbered accordingly.**
