RESOLUTION

WHEREAS groups of active American Legion members with a like interest in motorcycles and motorcycle riding have formed together in many Departments throughout The American Legion under the name "The American Legion Riders", and

WHEREAS the basic purpose of The American Legion Riders is the enjoyment of riding motorcycles and furthering The American Legion programs in the community, state and nation, and

WHEREAS the National Organization has approved The American Legion Riders as an activity, and has appointed a "National Liaison" to The American Legion Riders, and

WHEREAS The American Legion Emblem Sales has initiated sales of The American Legion Riders clothing and paraphernalia, and

WHEREAS in order to expand The American Legion Riders for the purpose of promoting The American Legion these groups wish to be recognized as a Department-wide activity NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED by The American Legion, Department of California, in Convention Assembled at Palm Springs, CA, on June 23-26, 2005 that Executive Committee of The American Legion Department of California establish an ADHOC committee consisting of one active member of The American Legion Riders from each Area which currently has an established unit of The American Legion Riders and two "technical advisors" from the general Department of California membership, and BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED that said committee shall be appointed by the final day of the Fall Department Executive Committee (DEC) Meeting 2005 for the purpose of studying the feasibility of the establishment of an American Legion Riders Committee, Commission or Separate Program to oversee, coordinate and promote the activities of The American Legion Riders within the Department of California, and BE IT FINALLY

RESOLVED that this ADHOC committee meet within ninety (90) days of its formation for the preparation of a written report and possible resolution(s) to be presented to the DEC and the General Membership at the Spring 2006 DEC Meeting, said date being in time for any interested Person, Post or District to take action on any recommendations made by the ADHOC committee at the 2006 Department of California Convention.
