# 10. Vice President Report - Brad Ring

#### 11. Area Reports

a. Area 1 VP - Bob Perryman

Post 521 is raffling a sportster. Would like to sell 10 in each area. Will be selling 1000 tickets @ \$25 each. Pictures are on the website. Several poker runs are planned and will be having a presidents meeting soon. Have gotten new members and about 90 percent are active.

#### b. Area 2 VP - Pete Calvert

Vietnam veteran memorial wall in Monterey county event went well. The riders have become the face of the Memorial. We have the rally coming up. 694 is down to 6 members. After visiting their meeting he found that they have concerns that with the 6 members and only two officers should they close the chapter? Requested help if possible from other area VPs if they have information that will help. Will be trying to visit DLI and Post graduate school to recruit members to help recruit members for 694.

Steve Storey asked that we verify if it is actually ok to recruit on the base. He had been reprimanded for doing it on his base.

Mick stated as long as you have permission from the base commander you can do it.

Other DEC members also stated that it is ok and is needed on the bases .

#### c. Area 3 VP – Randy Brenneman

The biggest thing they have going on is the fire at Lake Isabella. 150 homes destroyed chapter 711 has been affected directly. Some people have been able to return home but they still have no utilities. A go fund me account has been started along with money from other post, plus funds from Mick passing hat at the convention over \$ 6500.00 have been collected. The week before they had done a poker run to raise funds for a park that has pieces of the Arizona only place outside of Hawaii. Working on a chapter in the Tehachapi, will hopefully soon be turning in papers. Area meeting will be on 30 July.

Mick stated the American Legion DEC donated a large percentage of the over \$2,000.00 collected at convention. Also a reminder that National has a fund to supply \$3,000.00 for emergencies.
